Associate Memberships

Persons or business entities located outside Wasatch County may apply for membership in the Chamber/Bureau as Associate members. Associate Members shall be entitled to the same benefits accorded Full Members except the following:

1. Associate members shall not be entitled to vote at membership meetings or on any other matters requiring membership vote.
2. Associate members shall not be entitled to participate in Chamber/Bureau marketing programs, co-operative advertising programs, brochures listings, special events, trade shows and familiarization tours except upon approval of the Executive Committee or the Board of Directors when it is determined that such participation will not be detrimental to Wasatch County's interests or the interests of the Full Members as a group.
3. Associate Members may be subject to additional fees for participation in these programs.
4. Associate members will be charged \$20 in addition to the "base" dues assessed.

Secondary / Additional Memberships

Once a primary membership is established, a business can purchase additional memberships to promote secondary locations or other services available by the company (i.e., primary membership is an auto dealership, secondary membership is vehicle rental company). Please contact Jason Giles to discuss secondary memberships. Secondary / Additional Membership Considerations:

1. Members can receive up to three listings in different categories if applicable to the membership. (i.e., a restaurant provides fine dining in the evening, casual dining in the morning and catering – the restaurant would pay for one membership but could be listed in all three dining categories; an activity company offers horseback riding, guided fly fishing and snowmobile rentals – one membership listed in three different activity categories). However, if the services are not industry related, an additional membership must be purchased (i.e., a company provides massage therapy and operates a restaurant – not related, requires separate memberships).
2. Additional memberships may not be purchased in the lodging category.
3. The membership being charged the larger amount of dues will be considered primary.
4. Additional memberships are charged half the amount listed above.
