Chamber launches first ever Dine-About March 28 – April 9

Starting Monday, March 28, and running through April 9, over a dozen local restaurants have partnered with the Heber Valley Chamber of Commerce to offer lunch and dinner specials starting at \$7 and \$18 during the first ever “Heber Valley Dine-About.”
